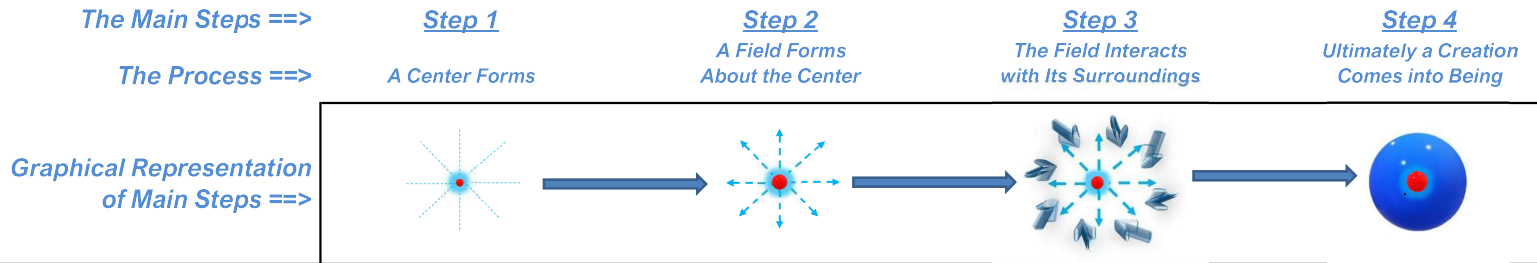

Nature's Great Creative Process!

Centerpath describes the universe's universal urge to center. It features the formation of powerful centers which, through the fields emanating from their surface (Centerfields) project a "center-oriented" configuration on the space in their surroundings.

Use this Worksheet to further your knowledge of how nature and your life are created.

Go into nature and consider where all things began, where they are in their cycle of being/life, and what comes next.

Get familiar with the creative process in nature. Trace the path of a bird to its nest and ants to their colony. Watch a cloud form overhead and observe the tide flow in and out twice a day on the beach.

Also, observe how your thoughts emerge and pass, observe the funneling inward towards a conclusion, and how movies and children's books rotate about a core theme or 'morale of the story'.

Seeing the common process underlying hosts of seemingly unrelated phenomena, you gain a window to the commonality all things share. You also glimpse the genius of the Great Creator's craft and the infinite wisdom it took to place it into motion.

The net effect shaping and molding things affected by the Centerfield into the larger center-oriented geometries of circles, spheres, spirals, clusters, branches, radials, & their hybrids.</p> <p>Listed to the right are the Items, Stuff, Substances, Objects, and Qualities Associated With Each Step of the Process</p>	<p>It begins with a first act of creation --the spontaneous formation of a center. The circumstances surrounding the formation of such centers is little known but appears to be a basic condition of matter-space, time-energy, void-beings interaction especially related to change occurring, energy flowing, or whenever matter-energy accumulate.</p> <p>Nature Examples: Amassing of matter, charge, energy. Extremes such as pressure & temp. Human Examples: The highest activity, the most attractive, impulses, thoughts, desires.</p>	<p>At the same time, the center turns around and radiates invisible 'fields' (Centerfields) deeply into the space surrounding them. We're all familiar with Centerfields in nature. They're the 'force-fields' associated with gravitational, electrical, and magnetic forces. They also apply to human activities such as with the fields of sight, sound, smell, information, action, and love.</p> <p>Nature Examples: Magnetic, electrical, gravitational, pressure gradients. Human Examples: Sight, sound, info, & love Psychic energy, thoughts, physical activities.</p>	<p>But no matter the type of field the outcome is always similarly the same. The field conditions the surrounding space --distorting and shaping it into a 3D well-shaped form about it which through their the vibration-like quality; in turn effects "like" things in its surroundings (electrons, entities, peoples, parts, etc.) causing them to stir, shake, move, react to, and align inward towards the object at the bottom and center of the well.</p> <p>Nature Examples: Field affects magnetic and electrical particles. Matter, electrons, air. Human Examples: Field draws in raw ingredients, resources, people.</p>	<p>Overtime the overall process shaping a group of "like" parts into a larger, coherent overall 'whole' form about its originating center (the overall shape of the whole in fact mimics the form of the invisible fields underlying them). Each and every such creation ultimately comprised of different composition and circumstances yet all sharing the same overall center skewed design about a single & central center --the place where it started & continues to grow from, and be</p> <p>Nature Examples: Atoms, cells, plants, planets. Herds, thunderstorms, mountains. Human Examples: Products, language, relationships, cities.</p>
